





FASSA BORTOLO INTERNATIONAL AWARD FOR SUSTAINABLE ARCHITECTURE

Built Projects - 16th Edition 2025

The International Prize for Sustainable Architecture has reached its sixteenth edition, with over eighty projects submitted from various European and non-European countries. The initiative, launched in 2003 by the Department of Architecture at the University of Ferrara on the occasion of its tenth anniversary, and promoted in collaboration with the company Fassa Bortolo, was born from the desire to reward and showcase architectural works that are in harmony with the environment, designed to meet human needs and capable of satisfying the requirements of current generations without compromising those of future generations through indiscriminate resource consumption and environmental pollution.

This year, on the occasion of its twentieth anniversary, the prize has updated its Article 1 by placing particular emphasis and recognition on projects that demonstrate a design and planning approach aimed at long-term flexibility and adaptability of building use, as well as the reversibility of construction elements and their future reuse.

The initiative alternates annually between a section dedicated to thesis projects (bachelor's, master's, and doctoral) and another, like this year, reserved for built works by professional architects.

The jury, chaired by Marianne Burkhalter (Atelier Burkhalter Sumi – Zurich), included Ken Yeang (T. R. Hamzah & Yeang – Ampang, Malaysia), Gerard Hausladen (Das Ingenieurbüro Hausladen), and Luca Rossato (Department of Architecture, University of Ferrara). The jury members, renewed with each edition, are appointed by the Scientific Committee, chaired by Thomas Herzog (Honorary President of the Jury, Thomas Herzog Architekten – Munich, Germany).

The jury awarded the Gold Medal to the project *Six Bricolage Houses* by the chinese studio Arcity Office, located in Nantou Ancient City, Shenzhen, China.

The two Silver Medals, as specified in the call for submissions, were awarded to the austrian studio Taelon7 for the *Fair Trade Zone* in Akuse, Ghana, and to *Stuttgart 210 – Living Lab Ingersheim* in Ingersheim, Germany, by Andreas Kretzer, Stefan Krötsch, Roman Kreuzer, Katharina Raabe, and Maximilian Stemmler.

Additionally, six projects from Japan, Spain, Belgium, Argentina, and Vietnam received Honourable Mentions.

As for the Fassa Bortolo Special Prize, a recognition granted exclusively to those who, while respecting the principles of sustainability and architectural quality, have successfully used solutions from the *Fassa Bortolo Integrated System*, the jury awarded the project *The Gold Inside* in Ravenna, designed by the Cesena-based studio Piraccini+Potente Architettura.







The Awards Ceremony will take place in the afternoon of **October 15, 2025**, in the prestigious setting of Palazzo Tassoni Estense, headquarters of the Department of Architecture at the University of Ferrara. Winners and all jury members will be invited to attend. As every year, the event is seen as a valuable opportunity for dialogue and exchange on sustainability-related themes, with a focus on the awarded projects.
